Search Capability

MK Quilts University's search capability has been much improved. In January 2023, MKQU added machine learning technology to transcribe video, audio, documents, and images to capture all the content from nearly 3,500 lessons. Now with this powerful technology, you can easily search MKQU for just the content you are seeking.

You can search the **All Courses Page** by typing your criteria into the blue search box. For instance, when typing "thread break" and pressing enter, there are 47 courses or bundles displayed almost instantly. You can then search the individual course for specifics.

Searching your Dashboard will return like results, but only in the courses in which you are enrolled.

Within a course (for this example in **2023 Q&A with MK** course), an even more powerful search is available in the search box at the top of the left side bar. Again, when searching for thread break, three lessons were found.

By clicking on the lesson from above, you are taken directly to the specific location in the video where thread break was discussed.

Use quotes to search for an exact phrase. For example, if you search for "bobbin tension" (including the quotes), the search will only return results that contain the exact phrase "bobbin tension". There is additional support for using "and" to search for results that contain **all** of the keywords you specify and using "or" to search for results that contain **any** of the keywords you specify. You can also use "and" and "or" together to create more complex searches.

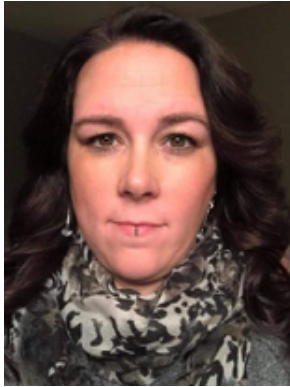

Older Video - MK showed the use of P2P triangles here aided by Art and Stitch to connect them all together so as not to have so many starts and stops. A similar technique using Pro-Stitcher Designer and the Connect (Ctrl-T) function is available.
